# 1. About This Manual

---

This manual provides instructions for safely using and maintaining your TARRAN All-Weather Bike Cover. Read and understand the entire manual before using this accessory with your T1 Pro.

## 2. Product Description

---



The All-Weather Bike Cover is designed to protect your T1 Pro from weather elements and dust when not in use. It features robust dust, rain, and sun protection, enhanced by an ABUS chain lock hole for security and dual reflective strips for nighttime visibility, as well as a compact storage pouch.

## 3. Specifications

- Material: Polyester, reflective tape, elastic cords

# 5. Safety Notices

---

## Warning!

- Keep the bike cover away from children when not in use. Plastic packaging and the cover itself may pose a suffocation risk.
- Ensure the bike has completely cooled down, especially the brake components, before covering, to prevent heat damage or fire risk.
- Do not ride the bike with the cover installed, as it may interfere with controls or cause accidents.
- Keep the cover away from children when not in use. This is not a toy and may pose a suffocation hazard.

## Caution!

- The bike cover is designed specifically for T1 Pro. Using it with other models may result in improper fitting.
- Secure all straps to prevent the cover from being blown away by wind or rolled up into wheels.
- Do not pull or stretch the elastic cords excessively as this may cause damage.

# 6. Installing the Bike Cover

---

## 6.1 Before Installation

1. Ensure the bike is powered off.
2. Lower the handlebar and saddle & quick-adjust seatpost to their minimum height positions.

- Engage the landing gears in kickstand mode for maximum stability.



**Note:** If parking and covering the bike outdoors, we recommend removing and safely storing the Central Display to prevent theft.

## 6.2 Installation Guide

1. Remove the bike cover from its storage pouch.
2. Unfold the cover and locate the two downward-facing arrows printed on the front.



3. Position the cover over T1 Pro, aligning the arrows with the front wheel.
4. Carefully pull the cover over the entire bike, ensuring both the front and back wheels are covered.
5. Pull the elastic tight around the bottom of the cover to secure the cover around the body of the bike.



6. Secure the bottom straps around the frame and wheels as indicated by the strap fastening points.



Front straps - secure through the front wheel



Back straps



**Note:** Without securing the straps, the cover could get rolled into the wheels.

7. Adjust the cover as needed to ensure a snug fit.

8. For ABUS chain lock access: Locate the reinforced hole on the side of the cover (marked with a ring) to thread your bike lock through.



# 7. Removing the Bike Cover

---

1. Unfasten all securing straps from the bottom of the cover.
2. Carefully lift the cover upward and away from the bike.
3. Fold the cover neatly to fit into the storage bag:
  - Fold in the sides
  - Fold from top to bottom
  - Roll or fold to the size of the storage pouch
4. Store in the provided pouch when not in use.

## 8. Care and Maintenance

---

- Machine wash cold with mild detergent when necessary.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not use hot water (above 40°C).
- Air dry flat only; do not tumble dry.
- Do not iron.
- Do not dry clean.
- Ensure the cover is completely dry before storing to prevent mold growth.
- Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.

## 9. Warranty
